COURSE DESCRIPTION

The training includes didactic discussion and group activities and will review perinatal conditions in which disparities in health outcomes are due to race, ethnicity or culture, discuss benefits of culturally proficient care in the health care encounter, review attributes of culturally proficient care, help practitioners become more aware of their own cultural values, beliefs and practices and how this affects interactions with others. We will also review the Office of Civil Rights (Title VI) regulations and Joint Commission requirements for hospitals.

EDUCATIONAL OUTCOMES/GOALS

Upon completion of this program the learner will be able to:

- Define the elements, attributes and influences of cultural proficiency
- Describe the characteristics of communication modification that impact perinatal care
- Discuss perinatal practices and beliefs of specific cultures that affect the health care encounter and strategies for managing transcultural practices

Nurses, physicians, and others who interact with families during pregnancy and childbirth, including postpartum and neonatal period. The beneficiaries of this culture-specific information include clinics, public health departments, physician/midwife offices, birthing centers, hospitals and academic programs.
